Browser/Java issues

- Chrome does not work with most administrative systems
- Other browsers may work for now but may not in the future. See Ted's notes on \\smccd.net\NAS\Software\PC_Files\Banner Software\OracleClient
- OS
 - Windows 7
 - Windows 10 – Ted has tested the following:
 - Hyperion (Studio)
 - Oracle Client 32 bit
 - SQL Developer
 - Banner INB
 - Argos Reports
 - BDM
 - Must do the following:
 - Install IE 11
 - Install java8
 - Install Adobe Acrobat XI Pro
- IE - we recommend IE 11 – older versions through 9 will work
- Java – we recommend 8 but 7 will work. Regardless, must configure based on Ted's notes.

Adobe and move to Adobe Creative Cloud

- Potential problems with Argos
- Need to install on computer to test
- Deploy only required applications, not all?
